In addition, we want our communities to understand the realities that we face as a shelter and the impact that our citizens can have on increasing adoption and decreasing euthanasia. We also believe early spay/neuter will reduce the number of unwanted animals entering the shelter. RHS is non-profit and an "open admission shelter" for 5 cities. "Open admission shelter" means that we accept all animals from the cities that we serve whether they are aggressive, old, feral, sick, injured or underage.
